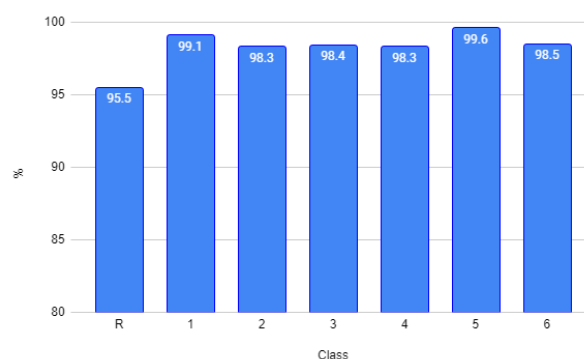
Thorn Grove Book Sale
