

# Bags 2 School

### **Autumn Parents Evening**

During this term's meeting, teachers will give parents a summary of how their child has settled, learning attitudes and behaviours, engagement within the classroom, friendships and a readiness to learn. ### **Census Day**



Thursday 5th October is the Autumn Term Census Day and this data return impacts our next year's funding. The money the school receives from the government to pay for the Infant schools meals is based on an average of the number of meals taken on the census days in October, January and May.

We would like to ensure Thorn Grove receives the maximum possible Universal Infant Free School Meal Funding in order to future proof the success of the school and give our children the best possible resources and staffing.

We will be having a special Space Themed dinner that day as it is World Space Week and all children in Year R, Year 1 and Year 2 (as well as children in other year groups who are eligible for free school meals) will have a school dinner prepared for them (please select from Planet Burgers or Meteorite Nuggets on LunchHound) and the expectation is for your child to try it.

We would therefore discourage packed lunches for Reception and KS1 pupils on this day.
